Writ Petitions under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in these circumstances stated therein and in the respective affidavits filed therewith the High Court will be pleased to

1) issue a WRIT OF MANDAMUS or any other WRIT, ORDER or DIRECTION in the nature of a WRIT by directing the respondents 1 to 3 to allow the sale of the assets of the 4th respondent through an Honourable Retired Judge of this Honourable court or an Advocate Commissioner appointed by this Honourable court to settle the depositors of the 4th respondent (in WP No.8084 of 2017) and

2) issue a WRIT OF certiorarified mandamus to call for the entire records pertaining to the proceedings of the 6th and 7th respondent in C.No.40/DSP/EOW-II/MDU/2015 dt.14.07.2015 (signed on 6.6.2016) and C.No.98(DISC)/DSP/EOW-II/MDU/2017 dated 4.5.2017 and quash the same and consequently direct the 1st respondent SEBI to consider and pass order on our representations dated 17.10.2016, 19.10.2016 and 23.01.2017 and further direct to grant permission to consider and pass the petitioner herein to proceed with the sale of the scheme properties and also permit the petitioner company to register sale deeds infavour of the third parties and eligible persons who deposited the amount for land from the petitioner company in the presence of the arbitrator appointed by Hon'ble High Court Hon'ble Mr. Justice G.M. Akbar ali, (Retd.,) appointed in WP.8084/2017 by orders dated 04.04.2017 on the file of this Hon'ble court and pay the sale consideration to the depositors on seniority basis in the presence of the sale consideration to the depositors on seniority basis in the presence of the said arbitrator (in WP No.18371 of 2017);

Order: These petitions coming on for orders upon perusing the petitions and the respective affidavits filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.T.MAHENDRAN, Advocate for the petitioner in WP.8084/2017 and of M/S.P.BAGYALAKSHMI FOR PETITIONER in WP.18371/2017 and of MS.LESI SARAVANAN Advocate for the respondent Nos.4 & 6 in each of the petitions the court made the following order:-

Applications for stay/modification of the order dated 11.10.2017 and the application filed against the letter dated 21.12.2017 of the Committee, were rejected by this Court by an order dated 24.01.2018.

- 2.Pursuant to the order dated 20.12.2017, the Revenue Secretary of the State Government has nominated two of his nominees as Committee members. It, however, appears that the second and third directions contained in the said order are yet to be complied with.
- 3.Ms.Lesi Saravanan, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Respondent Nos.4 and 6, submits that a Demand Draft of Rs.5,56,000/- has been forwarded to the Committee administering Disc Assets Lead (India) Limited, pursuant to the orders of this Court. Mr.M.S.Krishnan, however, submits that no such bank draft has yet been received.

4.Ms.Lesi Saravanan submits that the Managing Director has requested the Committee to recover the balance Rs.4,44,000/- by encashing mutual fund deposits. There was a specific direction on the Managing Director to transfer cash of Rs.10,00,000/-. The balance Rs.4,44,000/- will also have to be deposited.

5. There was a direction that the Company might sell shares in The Company has a Demat account which the Company had invested. M/s.Cholamandalam Ltd. Securities with M/s.Cholamandalam Securities Ltd. is directed to sell the shares and deposit the proceeds thereon in the joint account of the Committee. Since the sale is on account of the Company which has a Pan Card, there can be no question of insistence of any separate Pan Card in the name of the Committee or Pan Card of any of the Committee members.

6.Let the matter be listed 'for orders' as the first matter on 20.03.2018 for production of proof of delivery of the Bank Draft.

7.It is submitted that numerous applications are being filed in relation to the Company and/or its Directors in the Madurai Bench of the High Court. All matters pertaining to Disc Assets Lead Ltd. and/or its erstwhile Directors and/or present Directors shall be transferred to the Principal Bench and any further applications shall also be filed before this Bench. Registry of the Madurai Bench of this Court shall not entertain any applications relating to Disc Assets Lead (India) Ltd. or any of its Directors or erstwhile Directors in the Madurai Bench.
